

Commitment to Reuse and Recycling of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment

Spectra Group (UK) Limited (Spectra Group) supports the responsible reuse, recovery and recycling of waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE). Reusing and recycling WEEE helps to reduce raw material and energy use, divert waste from landfill and prevent hazardous substances contained in some WEEE from entering the environment.

Scope of this Notice

This notice applies to electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) supplied by Spectra Group to business customers in the United Kingdom. Spectra Group does not supply EEE to household or consumer customers, and this notice therefore relates to business-to-business WEEE only.

For the purposes of the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013, Spectra Group is a producer where it places own-brand EEE, or non-UK third-party EEE imported by Spectra Group, on the UK market for supply to business customers.

Spectra Group's WEEE producer registration number is WEE/MM7171AA.

B2B WEEE Take-Back Arrangements

Spectra Group is a member of the Wastecare WEEE Producer Compliance Scheme operated by Wastecare Compliance Plc, registration number 06043169. This scheme is approved by the Environment Agency under registration number WEE/MP3538PZ/SCH.

Spectra Group will accept relevant WEEE arising from business-to-business EEE that Spectra Group has placed on the UK market, for proper treatment, recovery and recycling. All returns are subject to prior confirmation and return authorisation. To request a return, business customers should email Spectra Group at RMA@spectra-group.co.uk, and provide details of the relevant EEE, including product type, quantity, serial number or other identifying information where available. Spectra Group will confirm whether the WEEE is accepted under its take-back arrangements and will provide return instructions following authorisation. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the business customer is responsible for the cost of transport and carriage of authorised WEEE to the return location specified by Spectra Group.

Business customers are responsible for ensuring that WEEE is packaged appropriately and safely for transport, handling and processing. Unauthorised returns, or returns that are not safely packaged, may be refused.

Before returning any WEEE, business customers must remove all personal data, confidential information and commercially sensitive information from the equipment. Spectra Group is not responsible for any data or information remaining on returned equipment.

Where EEE is marked with the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol, this indicates that the equipment should not be disposed of with unsorted waste and should be collected separately for proper treatment, recovery and recycling.

Waste Batteries

Where Spectra Group places batteries or products containing batteries on the UK market, it complies with its obligations under the UK waste batteries regime. Batteries should not be disposed of with unsorted waste. Business customers requiring information about the return, collection, treatment or recycling of waste batteries supplied by Spectra Group should contact us using the details set out above. Waste batteries must be handled through appropriate authorised collection, treatment and recycling routes.
